



FACTS **WHAT DOES CONNEXUS CREDIT UNION DO WITH YOUR PERSONAL INFORMATION?**

Why?	Financial companies choose how they share your personal information. Federal law gives consumers the right to limit some but not all sharing. Federal law also requires us to tell you how we collect, share, and protect your personal information. Please read this notice carefully to understand what we do.
What?	<p>The types of personal information we collect and share depend on the product or service you have with us. This information can include:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Social Security number • Account Transactions • Assets • Account Balances • Payment History • Checking Account Information <p>When you are <i>no longer</i> our customer, we continue to share your information as described in this notice.</p>
How?	All financial companies need to share members' personal information to run their everyday business. In the section below, we list the reasons financial companies can share their members' personal information; the reasons Connexus Credit Union chooses to share; and whether you can limit this sharing.

For our everyday business purposes — such as to process your transactions, maintain your account(s), respond to court orders and legal investigations, or report to credit bureaus	Yes	No

What we do	
How does Connexus Credit Union protect my personal information?	To protect your personal information from unauthorized access and use, we use security measures that comply with federal law. These measures include computer safeguards and secured files and buildings. We restrict access to information about you to those employees who need to know that information to provide products or services to you.
How does Connexus Credit Union collect my personal information?	We collect your personal information, for example, when you <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Open an account • Apply for a loan • Make deposits or withdrawals from your account • Show your government-issued ID • Give us your contact information We also collect your personal information from others, such as credit bureaus, affiliates, or other companies.
Why can't I limit all sharing?	Federal law gives you the right to limit only <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Sharing for affiliates' everyday business purposes—information about your creditworthiness • Affiliates from using your information to market to you • Sharing for nonaffiliates to market to you State laws and individual companies may give you additional rights to limit sharing.

Definitions	
Affiliates	Companies related by common ownership or control. They can be financial and nonfinancial companies. <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • <i>Connexus Credit Union has no affiliates.</i>
Nonaffiliates	Companies not related by common ownership or control. They can be financial and nonfinancial companies. <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • <i>Connexus Credit Union does not share with nonaffiliates so they can market to you.</i>
Joint marketing	A formal agreement between nonaffiliated financial companies that together market financial products or services to you. <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • <i>Our joint marketing partners may include companies that offer credit cards, insurance, or investment products.</i>

Other important information	
<p>AK, IL, MD and ND Members – We will not share personal information with nonaffiliates either for them to market to you or for joint marketing without authorization.</p> <p>CA Members – We will not share personal information with nonaffiliates either for them to market to you or for joint marketing without authorization. We will also limit sharing of personal information about you with our affiliates to comply with all CA privacy laws that apply to us.</p> <p>MA, MS and NJ Members – We will not share personal information for deposit or share relationship with nonaffiliates either for them to market to you or for joint marketing without authorization.</p> <p>VT Members – We will not share personal information with nonaffiliates either for them to market to you or for joint marketing without your authorization, and we will not share personal information affiliates about your creditworthiness without authorization.</p>	

Childrens Online Privacy Protection

Connexus' website is not designed to attract children and we do not knowingly collect, maintain, or use personal information from our website about children under thirteen years of age.

Online Tracking

Connexus uses cookies and other technologies to evaluate our web site and to track advertising leads and campaigns from banner Ads, and to gather information about site visitors' browsing activities. Connexus may hire a third party ad service company to track and report performance of advertising and marketing campaigns to and from Connexus and third party web sites and within our own website. We permit certain of these companies to set cookies and use related technology, such as tracking pixels. These tracking pixels and other similar tracking technologies may be used to collect and store information about user visits, such as the user's anonymous cookie ID, page visits and duration, and the specific ad or link(s) that the user clicked on to visit the site. No personally identifiable information is stored on these cookies or web pixels. This user activity information is reported to us in aggregate and is anonymous. We use this information in aggregate to understand, for example, the effectiveness of our advertising and marketing and so that we can determine what kinds of products and services are of most interest to you.
